HOURS / WORKING PATTERN

To promote a great work/ life balance, we have a mixture of shifts for our team. We are flexible and are open to candidates who want to do a **mixture of shifts**, **evenings only and weekends only**.

All our team work **alternate weekends and some evenings**, to make sure our clients are fully supported.

At interview stage we will have a chat about your availability to make sure the role suits you! We will discuss your needs, and build a set rota pattern, so you always know what days you are working.

Typical shift patterns might look like

7am – 2pm (Mornings)

3pm - 10pm (Evenings)

7am – 10pm (Full days)

However these times are flexible, and we can discuss this further at interview stage.

REQUIREMENTS

As your role will involve delivering care to people in their own homes, we are looking for drivers with their own car. However, we will endeavour to make sure you work in your local area, so you're never far from home!

For our senior roles, we are looking for candidates with at least 12 months experience, as well as drivers with their own car.



THE ROLES

Community Care Workers

- Delivering high-quality care services in accordance with individual care plans.
- Assisting clients with personal care tasks, including bathing, dressing, and toileting.
- Supporting clients with medication administration.
- Assisting with mobility and transfers, using appropriate techniques and equipment to ensure safety.
- Providing companionship and emotional support to clients and engage in meaningful conversations and activities.
- Assisting with meal preparation.
- Helping clients maintain their home. This could involve laundry, cleaning, and other domestic tasks.
- Promoting socialisation, taking clients out and about into their community!

Senior Community Care Workers

In addition to the above care worker duties, your day to day will also include;

- Performing spot checks on staff.
- Supporting new starters and signing off any training.
- Performing car risk assessments.
- Completing office duties, such as supporting with care plans and speaking with clients.
- On a rota basis, working on the 'on call phone', supporting the team and our clients.
